

[Vienna, 3<sup>rd</sup> September, 1787]

Today, 3<sup>rd</sup> September of the same year, I was so unfortunate as to lose, entirely unexpectedly, this Noble Man, dearest and best Friend and Saviour of my Life. – All is well for him! – but for me – us – [5] and all who knew him well, – but for us all will never be well again – until we are so fortunate as to see him in a better world – once more – and never to part again.

DME: Dr. Sigmund Barisani (\* 1758) died on 3<sup>rd</sup> September, 1787. He made an entry in the album on 14<sup>th</sup> April, 1787 (cf. Deutsch Dok p. 255). Sigmund Barisani was the younger son of the Salzburg Archbishop's personal physician, Dr. Silvester Barisani; he treated Mozart in 1784 for influenza and in 1784 for renal colic. His brother, Dr. Joseph Barisani (1756-1826) treated Leopold Mozart in Salzburg.
