1452. FRANZ XAVER WOLFGANG MOZART¹ TO CARL FRIEDRICH PETERS,² LEIPZIG

EXCERPT:

[Lemberg,³ 6th March, 1834]

. . . Under item one I will then also give myself the pleasure of sending you one of my father's manuscripts, but only a fragment,⁴ for I personally do not possess anything complete . . .

² BD: The publisher Carl Friedrich Peters died in 1827. The letters possibly addressed to the printer Wilhelm Paul in Dresden, as in the complete letter Franz Xaver demands a fee for the song *Frühlingsgruss*, which was published by Paul.
