\*BD VI, p. 352: Not Gottfried von Jacquin (his brother), as BD IV states. Joseph Franz made an entry in Mozart's album on the same day (with a quotation from Horace). Mozart wrote this sentence below the double canon "*Ach, zu kurz ist unsers Lebens Lauf*" KV 228 II (515b) ["Ah, too short is the course of our life"]. Their sister, Franziska, was one of Mozart's keyboard pupils (cf. note on No. 0972/2). Gottfried was the addressee of Mozart's letter of 15<sup>th</sup> January 1787 (No. 1022).

\*\*Mozart's English. BD: VI, p. 352: "faithful friend", not "faithfully friend", as erroneously printed in BD IV. Mozart wrote it under the notation of the double canon "*Ach, zu kurz ist unsers Lebens Lauf*" ["Ah, too brief is the course of our life"] KV 228 II (513b).
