

1103. MOZART TO HIS WIFE, VIENNA

Prague,<sup>1</sup> 31<sup>st</sup> *May*,  
1789.

Dearest, most treasured little wife! –

I have just this moment arrived. – I hope you have received my last letter of the 23<sup>rd</sup>. So everything remains as proposed; – I will duly reach the last, or first, post-stage<sup>2</sup> between 11 and 12 o'clock on Thursday, 4<sup>th</sup> *June*, and hope to meet you all there; do not forget to take someone with you to drive to the customs *office*<sup>3</sup> in my place. *Adieu*. God, how I am looking forward to seeing you again; – in haste.
